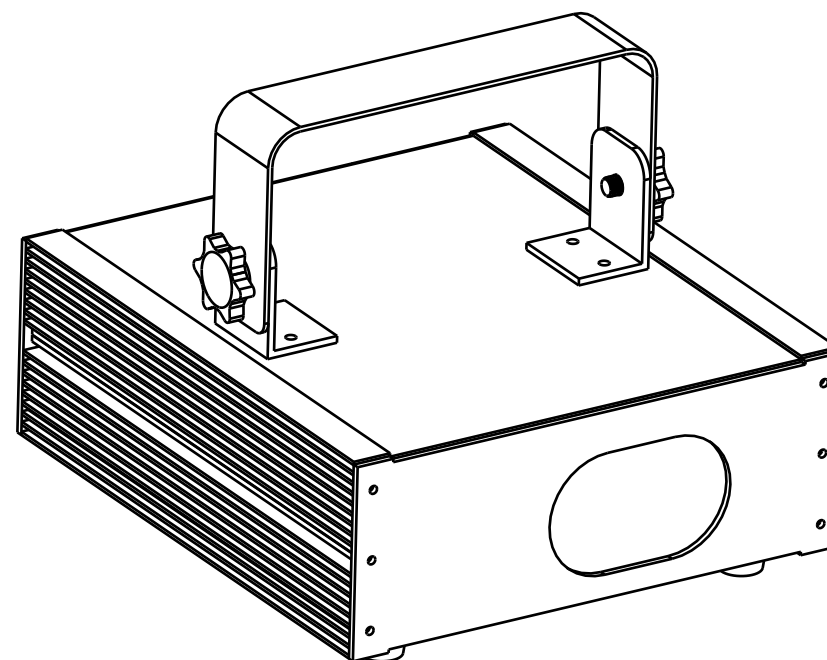

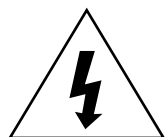
Unpacking:

These instructions contain important safety information regarding the use and maintenance of this unit. Please keep this manual with the unit, for future reference. Every unit has been thoroughly tested and has been shipped in perfect operating condition carefully check the shipping carton for damage that may have occurred during shipping. If the carton appears to be damaged that may have occurred during shipping. If the carton appears to be damaged, carefully inspect your unit for any damage and be sure all equipment necessary to operate the system has arrived intact. In the event that damage has been found or parts are missing, please contact our toll free customer support number for further instructions. Please do not return the unit to your dealer without first contacting customer support.

Notice:

1. please ensure the power supply good connect ground before operating, in order to prevent getting an electric shock.
2. This system is applicable to only indoor uses, and ensure the watertightness depending on the tide, quakeproof, its stable work. Making the environment temperature is 18~30°C, continue work time cannot over 4 hours, otherwise shorten the service life of the laser machine.
3. The system uses over a long period of time, during the light lens surface will adsorb the dust, lowering the exportation power of the laser machine, asking adoption to wipe the paper of lens sweeps.
4. Protect to fix the decals cannot tear, otherwise our company will be irresponsible to protect to fix.

Fuse Replacement

disconnect the unit's main power supply.use a flat head screw drive to unscrew the fuse holder .when the fuse holder is exposed remove the old fuse and replace it with the same type of fuse.when replacing and checking

Troubleshooting

1. If the power supply indicator does not light up and the laser does not work, please check if the power supply and the corresponding parts have the right input electric current.
2. If it is in stand-alone mode operation, the power supply indicator is light and the laser is not work, please check if the operation system is set up in Master/Slave mode.
3. If it is in Master/Slave mode, Slave mode is exceptional, please check as below:
 - A. Make sure to set up Master mode for just one unit. And the others are set in slave mode.
 - B. Make sure to control the unit with DMX controller.
 - C. Make sure to take a good quality power cord and connection.
4. If it is in DMX mode, the laser is uncontrolled by the DMX controller and the DMX signal indicator is unlighted, please check as below:
 - A. Make sure to set up the DMX mode
 - B. Make sure to have a good connection
5. If it is in DMX mode, the laser is uncontrolled by the DMX controller but the DMX signal indicator flash, please make sure the DMX controller and the laser have the same channel.
6. If the light direction is not on the way, please restart the power.

After trying the above solution you still have a problem, please contact your dealer or our company for service.

the fuse, be sure to check that the fuse has the metal ends completely exposed.

Control & Function

This unit uses dipswitches to assign a unit's function and DMX address in DMX MODE of function. Each dipswitch represents a binary value.

0=OFF 1=ON X=OFF or ON

Dipswitches #10, #11, and #12 is set system function, from #1 to #9 is set DMX512 address in DMX MODE.

DMX ADDR Calculate:

One unit has 8 channels; each unit assign 8 channels at least. We may assign 8 channels for one unit, then $ADDR = 8 \times N + 1$ $N=0,1,2,3,\dots$

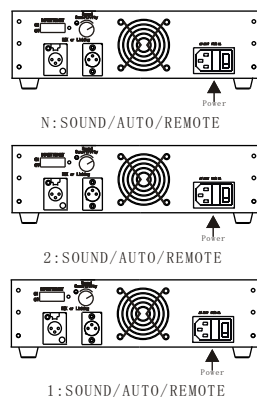
40 dynamic patterns and 40 static patterns, some static patterns can adjust size, All the dynamic patterns can not adjust size.

Operation

Stand-Alone Operation (Sound_Active, Auto Mode):

This mode allows a single unit to run to the beat of the music, or the unit will auto change in Auto Mode.

1. Set dipswitches position to Sound_Active or Auto Mode.
2. The unit will react to the low frequencies of music via the internal microphone in Sound_Active mode, or the unit will auto change in Auto Mode.
3. Use the audio sensitivity knob on the back of the unit to make the unit more or less sen-

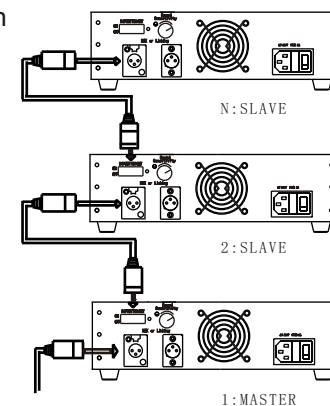


sitive in Sound_Active.

Master-Slave Operation (Master_Sound, Master_Auto):

This mode will allow you to link up to 32 units together without controller.

1. Use standard XLR microphone cable chain your units together via the XLR connector on the rear of the units. For longer cable runs we suggest a terminator at the last fixture.
2. Choose a unit to function as Master mode. Turn dipswitches to the Master Position on the unit. The unit must be first unit in line. Then simply chain the units together using XLR cable.
3. Turn switch to the Slave position on the slave units, and they will react the same as the Master.



Universal DMX Control (DMX Mode):

This mode allows you to universal DMX-512 controller to control light's operation or effect.

1. To control your fixture in DMX Mode.
2. Use standard XLR microphone cable chain your units together via the XLR connector on the rear of the units. For longer cable runs we suggest a terminator at the last fixture.
3. Assign a DMX address to the unit by following the dipswitch chart.
4. Use DMX controller to control your units.
